MERCURY 100 Hour Service

Should be performed every 100 hours or once per year, whichever comes first

- ✓ Lubricate all lubrication points
- ✓ Replace spark plugs at first 100 hours of the first year.
- ✓ Inspect thermostat visually for corrosion and broken spring.
- ✓ Check engine low pressure fuel filter contaminants
- ✓ Replace the high pressure fuel filter
- ✓ Check engine timing setup
- ✓ Check corrosion control anodes
- ✓ Lubricate splines on the driveshaft
- ✓ Check and adjust valve clearance, if necessary
- ✓ Inspect battery
- ✓ Check power trim fluid
- ✓ Check control cable adjustments
- ✓ Inspect timing belt
- ✓ Check tightness of bolts, nuts and other fasteners
- ✓ Check cowl seals to make sure seals are intact and not damaged
- ✓ Check internal cowl sound reduction foam to make sure foam
 is intact and not damage
- ✓ Check that the intake silencer is in place
- ✓ Check that the idle relief muffler is in place
- ✓ Check for loose hose clamps and rubber boots on the air intake assembly
